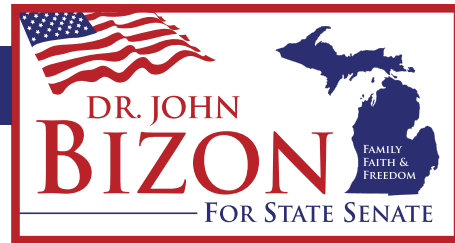


Where He Stands: *The Sanctity of Life*
